This fun and challenging intensive is perfect for musical theatre students to experience the YATP program while expanding and improving their technique & skillset. Not "pay-to-play", our program teaches solid technical skills for young, professional artists. This is a "long game" program for serious, dedicated students seeking a higher level of study. We work hard while having fun and building confidence.

Students will work on proper vocal technique, along with acting, audition techniques and dance skills, while also preparing ensemble numbers from a rotating mix of classic and contemporary, age appropriate, Broadway Musicals, under the leadership of Stephanie Riggs, Educational Director/Master Teacher, YATP Faculty & several talented YATP interns with a very low teacher/student ratio allowing for much personalized and 1:1 attention.

Students should bring a sack lunch, bottled water and snack daily. All students should have a pencil, binder, and recording app on phone (to make recordings in class for at home practice) each day. Wear clothes to move in with rubber-soled shoes & hair tied back. Detailed emails with daily schedule breakdowns, what to prepare for the BEST camp experience ever, and other details will be sent prior to the start of camp.
